

How to Deploy the .NET Compact Framework CAB File

The zip file that you download contains two files, this file that you are reading and a folder with a CAB installation file(s). You must extract the CAB folder from the zip file and move the CAB file onto your PDA or Smartphone. In the case of the armv4i processor with Windows Mobile 5 or 6, the extracted folder contains two files. You must choose which one is appropriate for your device. The most common one is the NETCFv2.wm.armv4i.cab file. Contact your manufacturer if necessary.

Caution: Do not unzip the files in the CAB file! The entire CAB file must be moved to your PDA or Smartphone, intact. Your PDA or Smartphone knows that a CAB file is a program installation file. Transfer the CAB file using ActiveSync or whatever sync program that you use for your PDA or Smartphone. Find the transferred CAB file on your PDA or Smartphone and select it and hit enter. The software will deploy. After deployment, delete the CAB file. Find the trefoil icon for the application, select it and hit enter.
